

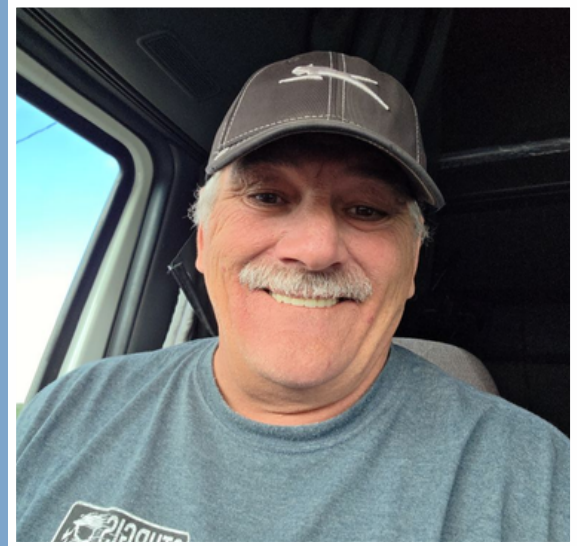


2026 Q1 Impact Report

St. Christopher Truckers Relief Fund is a non-faith-based 501(c)(3) that provides financial assistance to over-the-road, Class A truck drivers who are unable to work due to a recent illness or injury and are facing financial hardship.

SCF also offers free preventive health and wellness programs to support a healthier driver community, including nicotine cessation, diabetes prevention, chronic disease management, at-home cancer screenings, and vaccine vouchers for uninsured drivers covering flu, shingles, COVID-19, and pneumonia.

A New Mile Marker in Women's Health: Cervical Cancer Screening Launch

St. Christopher Truckers Relief Fund (SCF) is expanding its commitment to truck drivers' health by introducing access to cervical cancer screening as part of its wellness initiatives. Recognizing that professional drivers often face significant barriers to preventive care—such as time constraints, limited access to providers on the road, and lack of regular checkups—this new effort focuses on making early detection more accessible and achievable. By supporting screening and increasing awareness, SCF aims to help women in the trucking community catch potential issues earlier, when they are most treatable, while reinforcing the organization's broader mission to promote health, stability, and long-term well-being for drivers and their families.

This effort reflects SCF's continued evolution in serving the whole health of the trucking community—extending beyond immediate financial assistance to include proactive, preventive solutions that promote long-term wellness. By integrating cervical cancer screening into its suite of health-focused programs, SCF strengthens its role as a trusted partner in supporting drivers and their families, helping them stay healthier on the road and at home.

- 242 drivers quit smoking
- 158 cut tobacco use in half since the program began in 2007
- 8 quit, 5 cut back YTD
